When will I hear back?

Schools are busy places and often our staff have little flexibility in when they are able to dedicate time to responding to emails due to teaching or other commitments or indeed absence from school for illness, professional development or other possible reasons. Generally speaking, we will aim to respond to any email or phone message within **48 weekday hours**.

If you have not had a response within **two full working days** (eg if you make contact early on a Tuesday and you have not had a response by the end of Thursday) then please forward your email to the “escalation contact” below. This mailbox will be monitored with the aim that we can be able to support the team that you have contact to get a response to you or to provide reassurance that your contact is being addressed.
